

LETTER FROM JAMES TOWERS
TOWN ADMINISTRATOR

Dear Resident,

During a meeting of the Tiverton Town Council held on February 24, 2003, I committed to the residents of the greater Bay Street section of town that a meeting would be scheduled to provide answers to the many questions citizens were asking regarding the soil that was discovered beneath Bay Street during the construction of the sewer line last fall.

Recently, the SIR (Site Investigation Report) has been prepared on behalf of the Town of Tiverton and Starwood Tiverton, LLC. The purpose of the SIR was to delineate the extent of soil contamination on town owned property in the area between Judson Street and Foote Street along Bay Street. The SIR in its final form is now available for distribution.

Tiverton is continuing to work with RIDEM to prepare a strategy for further sampling and analysis in the area. I have also scheduled the promised meeting in support of your concerns with DEM and the Dept. of Health. I am pleased to facilitate such a meeting so that your concerns can be answered by the experts in the relative agencies of the state.

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, March 18, 2003**, in the council meeting room of the **Town Hall; 343 Highland Road**. The scheduled time for the meeting is **6:00 PM** and the following will be present to answer questions that you have:

- Jeffery Crawford, Principal Environmental Scientist, RI DEM
- Thomas Boving, PhD., Professor of Geosciences, University of RI
